American Jewish University continues to monitor events related to Coronavirus (COVID-19) and will continue to send updates and information as needed. AJU is in contact with public health officials as they release information about how to respond to COVID-19. **At the present time, all classes, events and campus operations are continuing as usual.**

AJU has also taken the following measures to ensure the safety of our community:

- Our maintenance staff has enhanced janitorial services throughout both campuses and has added maintenance personnel to both our daytime and evening crews in order to increase the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting public spaces.
- Campus leadership is discussing how learning can continue should our campuses become affected by COVID-19 and we continue to develop strategies to address this should it become necessary.

AJU asks that you follow the local Department of Public Health's recommendations to protect yourselves and others from respiratory illnesses:

- **Stay home when you are sick.**
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after using the restroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Limit close contact, like sharing cups or utensils, with people who are sick.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash immediately.
- Get a flu immunization if you have not done so this season.
