

DRIVE-IN MOVIE SAFETY & HEALTH RULES

HECKING IN

- At event entrance, please have tickets ready to scan (on either your mobile device or printed on paper) to facilitate check-in.
- Doors open for at 5:00pm. Screening begins at 7:00pm.
- Please Note: Oversized cars, SUV's, mini-vans, and trucks are parked towards the back to allow for unobstructed views for everyone.
- Please allow ample time for parking. There is a parking queue so that we can custom park and distance each car.
- To ensure a safe environment, please do not open convertibles or the back of SUVs.
- After the screening, please wait for the parking staff to direct your exit so that we can avoid exit traffic congestion.

EALTH & SAFETY

- If you or anyone within your group has or is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, we ask you to please stay home to ensure the health and safety of our audience and staff.
- All attendees must wear masks when interacting with staff and when outside of the vehicle to go to the restroom.
- Cars must park 6 feet apart from each other. Parking attendants will assist you.
- Guests must remain in vehicles at all times unless going to the restrooms.
- Dogs are not recommended due to government restrictions.
- SFC and BBC Staff are required to wear masks to ensure your safety.
- Restrooms are available for public use.

EHICLE & PARKING

- One ticket is good for one vehicle, no RV's/motorhomes allowed.
- Upon entry, parking ushers will direct vehicles to parking space assignments.
- Parking spaces will be assigned based on vehicle size. This is not a first-come, first-served event and you will not be able to choose your parking space.
- Parking spaces will be laid out to allow social distancing as per County public health order.
- Vehicles will be allowed to pull in or back into their assigned parking space.
- If raising a hatch, please be prepared to tie or strap the hatch down halfway to avoid blocking views.

• If you are using your car radio, please turn on your engine once in awhile to avoid draining your car battery. Please be mindful to turn off your headlights as it will disrupt the movie screen.
