Where to Start Your Digital Research

- 1. Databases: The library subscribes to various databases that are useful for education students. Some popular databases include Gale, JSTOR, and Education Source. These databases provide access to academic journals, research studies, and other scholarly resources.
- 2. How to Videos: The library provides access to educational videos on a variety of subjects, including how to use the stacks and how to login to access the library's online resources.
- 3. Research Guides: The library's research guides are a great resource for education students. These guides provide tips and strategies for conducting research in specific subject areas, such as literacy education, early childhood education, or special education.

- 4. Interlibrary Loan: If the library does not have a book or article that you need, you can request it through interlibrary loan. This service allows you to borrow materials from other libraries that are not available at your home library.
- 5. <u>Librarians</u>: The library's reference librarians can provide assistance with research and help you find the resources you need. You can contact them via email, phone, or in-person to ask questions or schedule a research consultation

6. Open Access Resources:

Electronic resources made widely available on the internet without licensing restrictions, including PubMed Central (PMC), Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), Open Access for Scholarly Content (OASC). More on page 5.

Getting Started With Using AJU's Library Databases

What is a database? AJU Library subscribes to several online databases. A "database" is basically an online source of information which has a search engine. In a database you can find various journals and articles based on title, author, subject, or keyword.

Our online subscription resources can always be accessed from **computers** and **wireless networks** on campus. **Off-campus access** is restricted to current AJU students, faculty, and staff who have an AJU email.

A Selection of Education Resource Databases

Open Access Databases

Open access resources are electronic resources made widely available on the internet without licensing restrictions (no paywall)

- <u>American Libraries</u>: A sub-collection of the Open-Access Text Archive section of the Internet Archive. The focus is on text collections contributed by U.S. libraries.
- <u>Children's Library</u>: A sub-collection of the Open-Access Text Archive section of the Internet Archive. The focus is on books for children.
- <u>Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB)</u>: A growing collection of more than 44,000 online, open access scholarly books. The primary aim of DOAB is to increase discoverability of Open Access books.
- <u>Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)</u>: Date coverage varies. Free, full text, quality controlled scientific and scholarly journals, covering all subjects and languages. There are more than 16,000 journals and 6.5 million article records in the directory.
- <u>Eduref.org</u>: Dates vary. Includes over 2,000 lesson plans and other resources and services to the education community. From the Information Institute of Syracuse.
- <u>HathiTrust Digital Library</u>: a partnership of academic and research institutions, offering a collection of millions of titles digitized from libraries around the world.
- Open Access for Scholarly Content (OASC): access to images of art in its collection that the Museum believes to be in the public domain and free of other known restrictions; these images are now available for scholarly use in any media.
- <u>PubMed Central (PMC)</u>: a free full-text archive of biomedical and life sciences journal literature in the U.S. National Institutes of Health's National Library of Medicine.



You can search a database directly, or search a specific database within AJU Library Catalog Advanced Search.



Once you search for your keyword, subject, title, author, etc, you can then narrow your search results to only show items in AJU's database, rather than Libraries Worldwide. This means you can immediately access the article.


